# PREFERENCE POINTS CLAIM FORM IN TERMS OF THE PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT REGULATIONS 2022

This preference form must form part of all tenders invited. It contains general information and serves as a claim form for preference points for specific goals.

# 1. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1.1 The following preference point systems are applicable to invitations to tender:
  - the 80/20 system for requirements with a Rand value of up to R50 000 000 (all applicable taxes included); and
  - the 90/10 system for requirements with a Rand value above R50 000 000 (all applicable taxes included).
- 1.2 The applicable preference point system for this tender is the 80/20 preference point system.
- 1.3 Points for this tender (even in the case of a tender for income-generating contracts) shall be awarded for:
  - (a) Price; and
  - (b) Specific Goals.
- 1.4 Failure on the part of a tenderer to submit proof or documentation required in terms of this tender to claim points for specific goals with the tender, will be interpreted to mean that preference points for specific goals are not claimed.
- 1.5 The organ of state reserves the right to require of a tenderer, either before a tender is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the organ of state.

# 2. **DEFINITIONS**

- (a) "tender" means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation to provide goods or services through price quotations, competitive tendering process or any other method envisaged in legislation;
- (b) "price" means an amount of money tendered for goods or services, and includes all applicable taxes less all unconditional discounts;
- (c) "rand value" means the total estimated value of a contract in Rand, calculated at the time of bid invitation, and includes all applicable taxes;
- (d) "tender for income-generating contracts" means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation for the origination of income-generating contracts through any method envisaged in legislation that will result in a legal agreement between the organ of state and a third party that produces revenue for the organ of state, and includes, but is not limited to, leasing and disposal of assets and concession contracts, excluding direct sales and disposal of assets through public auctions; and

(e) "the Act" means the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act No. 5 of 2000).

# 4. POINTS AWARDED FOR SPECIFIC GOALS

4.1. In terms of Regulation 4(2); 5(2); 6(2) and 7(2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded for specific goals stated in the tender.

For the purposes of this tender the tenderer will be allocated points based on the goals stated in table 1 below as may be supported by proof/ documentation stated in the conditions of this tender:

- 4.2. In cases where organs of state intend to use Regulation 3(2) of the Regulations, which states that, if it is unclear whether the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system applies, an organ of state must, in the tender documents, stipulate in the case of
  - (a) an invitation for tender for income-generating contracts, that either the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system will apply and that the highest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system; or

# 1. Background

1.1. The Municipality intends to appoint a suitable supplier for the supply, delivery and off-loading of refuse bags for a period of twelve (12) months.

#### 2. Current State

2.1. To maintain the town's cleanliness, the Municipality requires regular supplies of refuse bags for general waste collection. However, the current system of procuring bags only when needed leads to service delays. This is due to the necessary procedures involved in obtaining them, and unforeseen delivery issues can further disrupt waste collection.

# 3. Scope of Work

- 3.1. The appointed service provider will be required to supply and deliver refuse to the municipality through the following process:
- 3.1.1. The Municipality will place an order for refuse bags according to the rate per bag of the approved supplier. The purchase order will contain the quantity of the refuse bags required.
- 3.1.2. The supplier will be required to acknowledge receipt of the purchase and confirm the delivery date, which <u>must be eight (8) days after receipt and confirmation of purchase order</u>.
- 3.1.3. If the supplier fails to deliver the refuse bags within the period specified above, the Municipality shall without prejudice to its other remedies, deduct from the purchase order amount, as a penalty. The penalty for failing to deliver on time is **R 500.00 per calendar day**.
- 3.1.4. The penalty does not apply in the event of Force majeure.
- 3.1.5. A delivery note with a valid tax invoice must be given to the Municipality with each delivery. The delivery note and valid tax invoice must be according to the quantities and amount of the purchase order.
